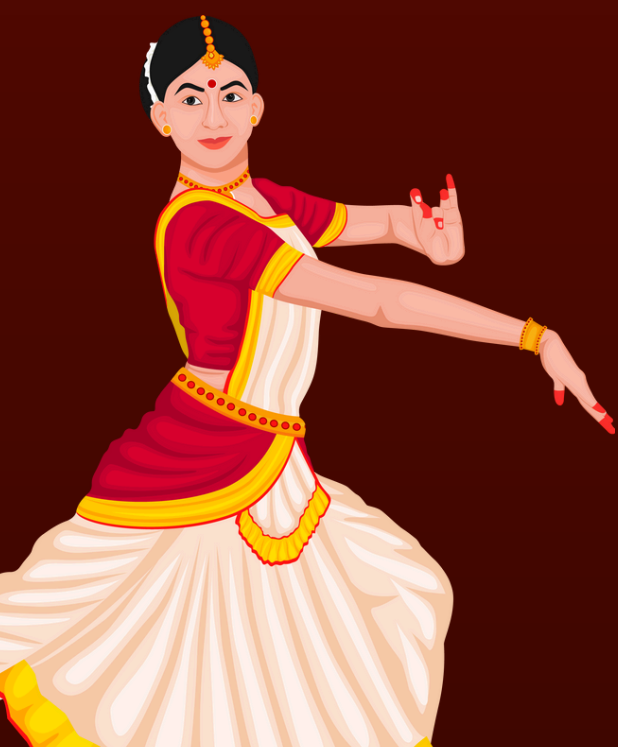

Rules:

Baton must be exchanged within the exchange zone

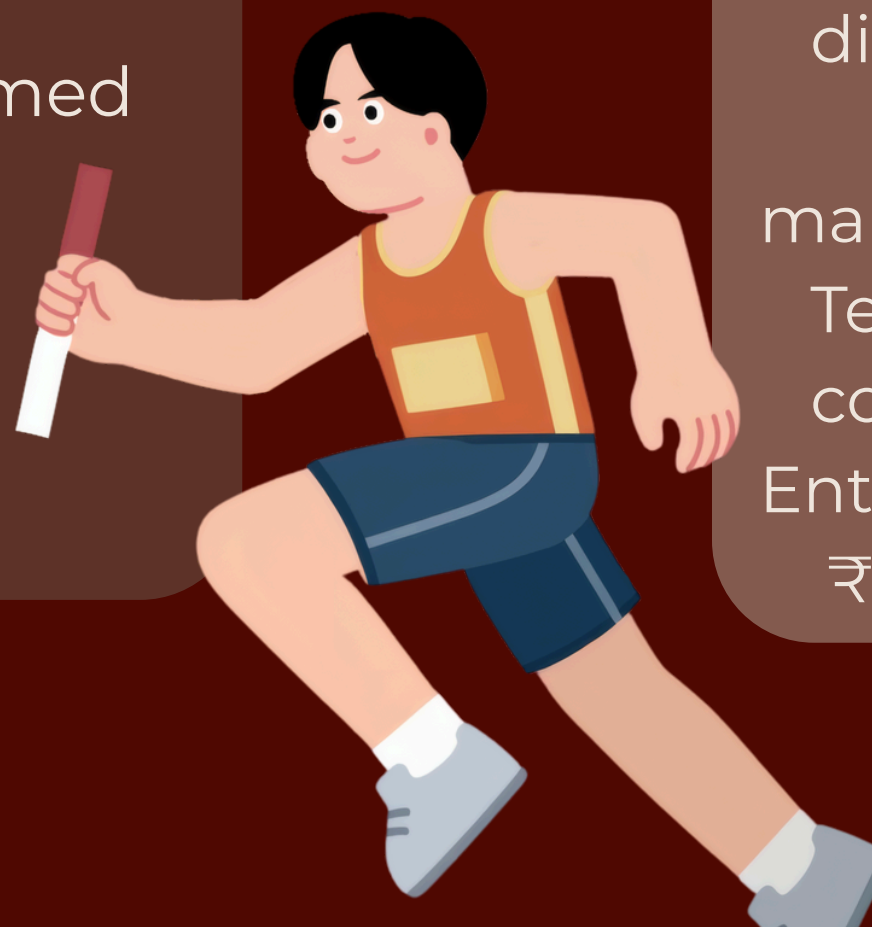
Dropped baton → penalty / disqualification

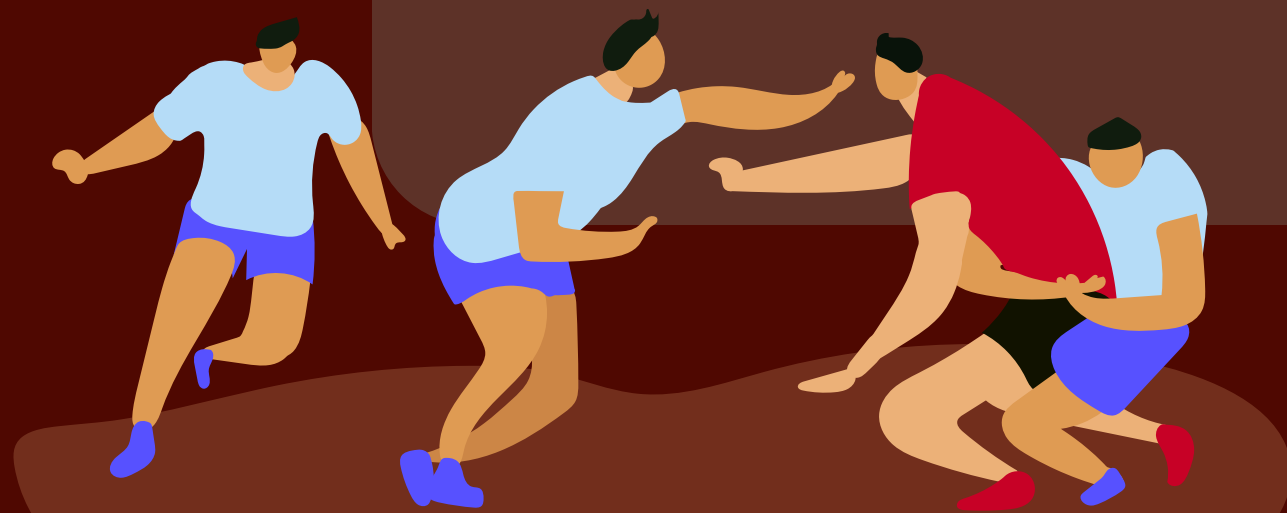

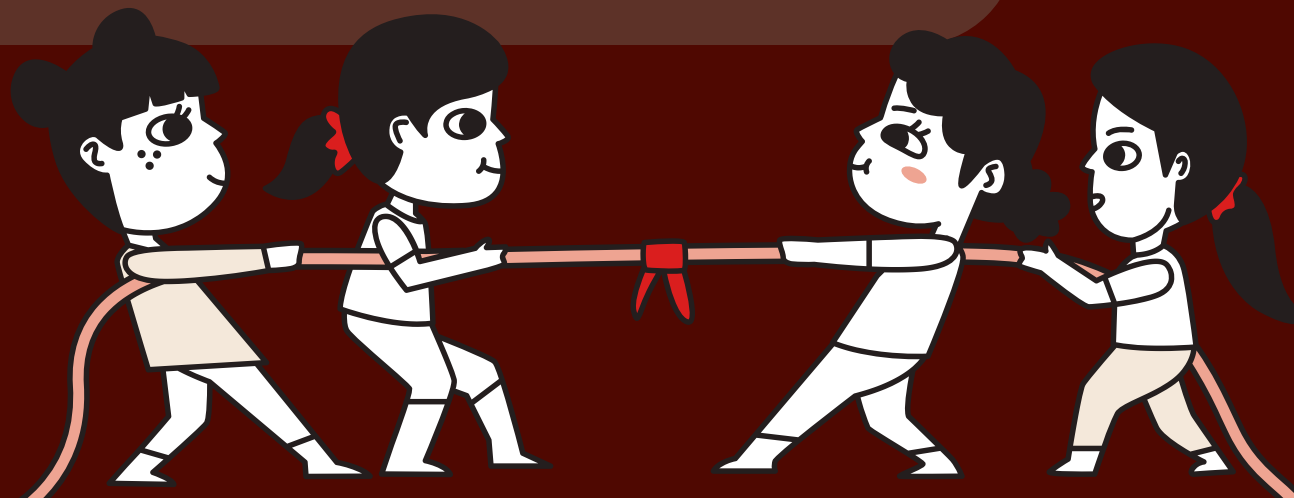
Team vs Team

Format:

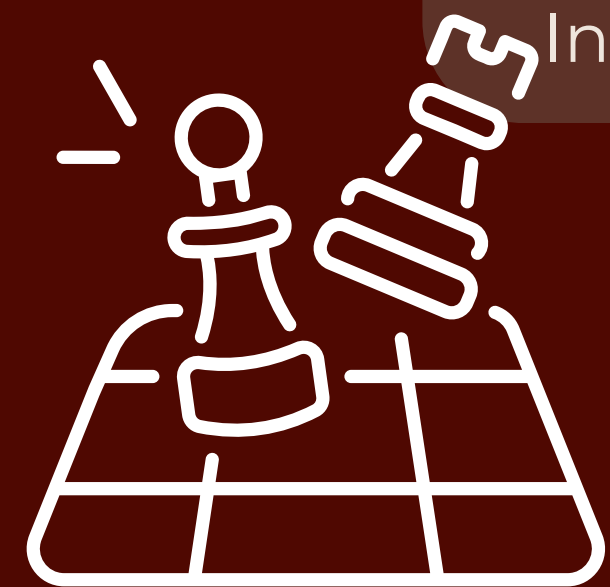
Individual match
